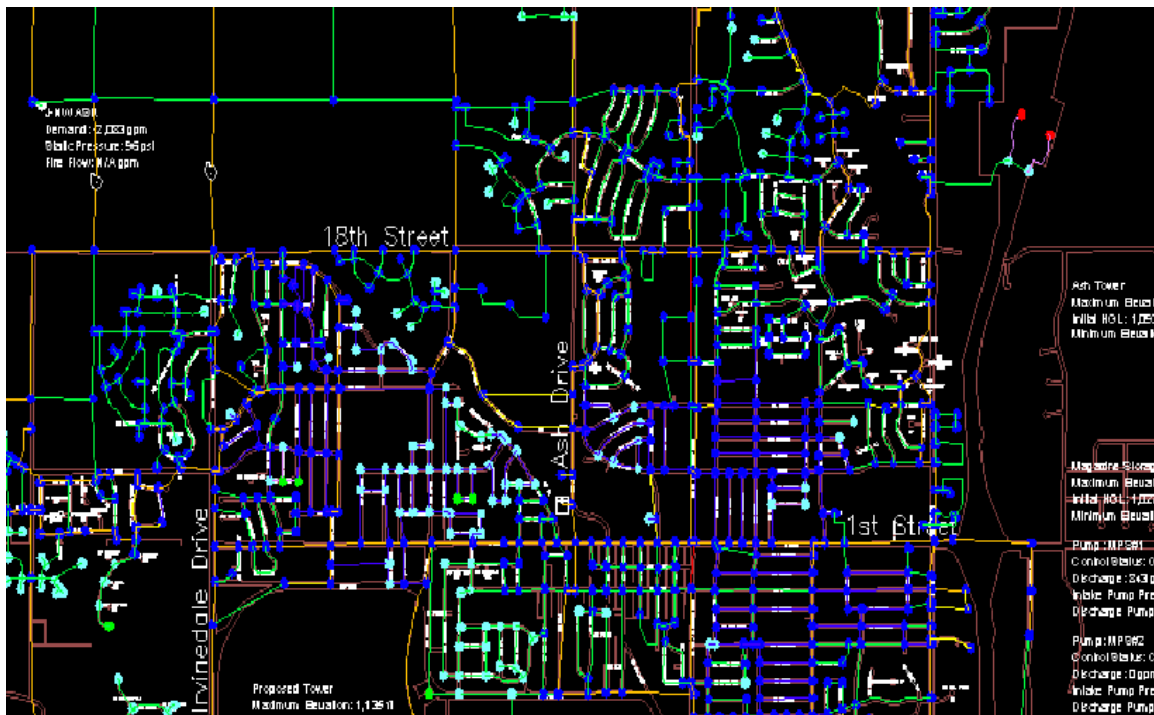


FOX Employee Attends HAE Water Distribution Design and Modeling Seminar

Matt Kasper recently attended a week-long training seminar to upgrade his water distribution modeling skills.
